

LRSCA Constitution Rule 7)c)

Proposed Change to Rule 7) Subscriptions and Registration Fees

The present Constitution Rule 7)c) reads:

7) Subscriptions and Registration Fees

c) The Certification Fee shall be decided at the Annual General Meeting. This shall be paid when a Lymington River Scow is measured and a certificate issued.

The Proposed Rule 7)c) reads:

7) Subscriptions and, Registration and Licence Fees

c) The Registration and Licence Fee shall be decided at the Annual General Meeting. The Registration and Licence Fee shall be paid before the Builder is authorised to use the mould for a new Lymington River Scow. On completion of build, and following measurement by the Class Measurer, the Measurement Certificate shall be issued.

Reason for change:

There is already a reference to Registration in Rule 7 but this is not followed through in subsequent text.

It is proposed that what is presently described as a Certification Fee (presently £50.00) is to be re-classified as a Registration, and Licence Fee.

Registration – Authorising the use of L^R insignia on the sail, issuing the HIN/Sail Number.

Licence – Authorising the use of the LRCSA owned moulds.

It should thus be clearer that the payment is required before the Builder can use the moulds. Before building can commence. This suggestion was made by John Claridge. This should eliminate the problem of trying to chase payments from new Owners when the boats have left the Builder's yard.
